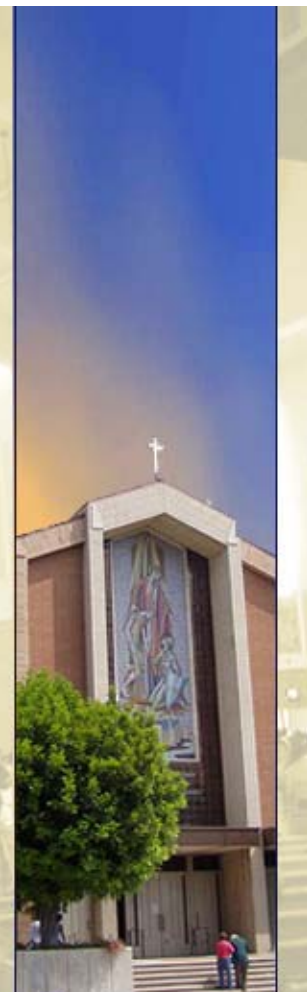

### ALL ABOUT CHANGE

On this Second Sunday of Lent the scriptures remind us that when we have an encounter with our God, things are bound to change. In the first reading God tells Abram to raise his eyes to the sky, promising descendants as numerous as the stars. Abram's act of faith in the Lord is sealed in covenant, forever changing the course of salvation history. In the Gospel story of the Transfiguration, always proclaimed on this Lenten Sunday, the Lord Jesus changes in appearance before the eyes of the apostles who, like Abram, raise their eyes to the spectacle in the sky. It is Saint Paul who brings it all together for us: "He will change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (Philippians 3:21). Lent is all about change, all about conversion. Let us cast our own eyes to heaven, awaiting that day when we will be changed—when we will share in Christ's glory.

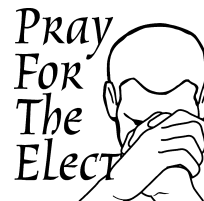

Al llegar a sus puestos, la madre se fijó en una amiga y fue a saludarla. El pequeño, por su parte, se alejó de su puesto y abrió una puerta con un letrero que decía “Prohibido pasar”. Las luces ya habían bajado cuando la madre se dio cuenta que su hijo no estaba. ### Timeline of Faith

**1950-1951**

May 24, 1950

Cardinal James McIntyre establishes St. Genevieve Parish. Father Michael J. Ryan is appointed as founding Pastor.

May 28, 1950

First Mass celebrated in the Panorama Theatre.

June 15, 1950

An election was held and the first Parish Council was established.

September 25, 1950

Father Ryan announced plans for the building of a church and elementary school. He also announced that he has secured the services of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Newark.

October 1950

Sister Marian James, CSJ, Sister St. Anne, CSJ, and Sister Cecilia, CSJ, arrived to serve the parish.

October 25, 1950

Religious Instruction Classes were held for the children of the parish for the first time.

December 6, 1950

The first Choir Rehearsal was held in the Parish Hall with an Invitation to all men and boys who had "Knowledge of singing" and the ability to "Follow simple musical notes."

January 26, 1951

Construction began on the new, temporary church and elementary school.

Spring, 1951

Sister Cecilia, CSJ, began a kindergarten class in the old warehouse on the parish grounds.

August 1951

Construction on the first phase of the elementary school was completed. The first portion of the school consisted of eight Classrooms and office space.

August 26, 1951

Mass was celebrated in the new, temporary church.
