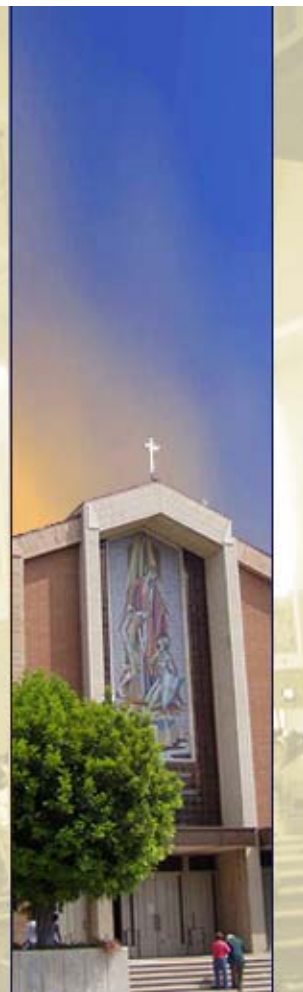

DID YOU KNOW?

Always Keep an Up-to-Date Photo of Your Child

Picture this: A good photo could save a child's life. One of the most important tools for law enforcement in the case of a missing child is an up-to-date (take a new one every six months), good-quality photograph. The photograph should be a recent head-and-shoulders color photograph of the child in which the face is clearly seen. It should be of school-portrait quality, and the background should be plain or solid so it does not distract from the subject. When possible, the photograph should be in a digitized form and available on a compact disk (CD), as opposed to just a hard copy. This minimizes the time necessary to scan, resize, and make color corrections before disseminating it to law enforcement. The photograph should have space for accurate, narrative description useful to identify the child, such as name, nickname, height, weight, sex, age, eye color, identifying marks, glasses, and braces. Siempre Mantenga Una Fotografía Actual de Sus Hijos

Una fotografía actualizada y en buenas condiciones es una de las herramientas más importantes que las autoridades pueden utilizar en el caso de un niño perdido. La fotografía del niño debe ser reciente, de cabeza a hombros, la cara bien visible y a color. Debe tener la calidad de un “retrato escolar”, y el fondo debe ser claro o de color oscuro para que no distraiga del sujeto. Si es posible, la fotografía debería estar disponible no solamente en papel, sino también en forma digital y en un disco compacto (CD). Esto disminuirá considerablemente el tiempo necesario para cambiar el tamaño, copiar, y corregir el color de la fotografía antes de entregarla a las autoridades. La fotografía debe ser actualizada por lo menos cada seis meses para los niños menores de 6 años, y después una vez al año o cada vez que los niños cambian de aspecto.

My dear Parishioner:

I am happy to announce that the Most Reverend Archbishop has established St. Genevieve's Parish and, has named me its first Pastor. The Rectory is situated on the property which is bounded by Roscoe Boulevard, Hazeltine Avenue, Community Street and Colbath Avenue. However, until such time as we are able to convert one of the buildings on our property into a temporary Church, we will have two Masses on Sundays and Holy Days at the Panorama Theatre on Van Nuys Boulevard. The Masses will be at 8:30 and 10:30 a.m.

We will be privileged to have our first Masses this coming Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, May 28, and I extend to you and to the members of your family an invitation to join with me on Sunday in offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for your intentions and for the intentions of all the members of my Parish.

I trust I shall have the pleasure of meeting you on Sunday, and I would be grateful if you would inform your Catholic neighbors of the time and place of our Masses, as I am sure there are many Parishioners whose names I do not have.

I assure you and family of a constant remembrance in my Masses and prayers, and I earnestly request your good prayers that Almighty God may pour down His Blessings on our Parish and its Parishioners.
