THE NEW SAINT GENEVIEVE'S SCHOOL

YOUR PARISH—SAINT GENEVIEVE'S

As indicated on enclosed map, you can see that you live in SAINT GENEVIEVE'S PARISH, and so you and family are members of this Parish, sharing in its Blessings as well as its burdens. You may live near us or a far distance from us, but still, according to one of the Commandments of the Church, your responsibility is to your own Parish, St. Genevieve's. For the administration of the Sacraments it is your Priest in your Parish who is responsible. And it is my privilege, as well as my duty, to help solve the problems, of a spiritual nature, that are brought to me. In this connection I am happy, at any time, to meet my Parishioners, and they are most welcome whenever they wish to call at the Rectory.

YOUR NEW PARISH CHURCH

A new Parish Church, in which you will attend Mass and all Liturgical Services, and in which you and your family will receive the Sacraments, is now being constructed. This beautiful Church, of reinforced brick construction, will have a seating capacity for more than eight hundred persons. The large Sanctuary will have a marble High Altar, and there will be a Shrine of Our Blessed Lady and a Shrine of Saint Joseph. The Choir, built over the Vestibule, will have a Liturgical Organ, and a seating capacity for seventy-five Choir Members. There will be no columns or pillars, so that all parts of the Sanctuary may be seen from every portion of the Church. The Facade will have a beautiful and decorative design surmounted by a large Celtic Cross. This Church, built in the center of our Parish site, will face Roscoe Boulevard. We hope to have our first Mass in our new Church early in July.

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MEMBERS OF OUR PARISH

I am sure it will not be necessary to stress the responsibility of our Parishioners in cooperating, to the fullest degree, in carrying out the Program I have outlined. A beautiful Church, in which you and family can worship God, will be a reality very soon. A Parish School, in which your children will receive a thorough Christian education, will be a reality very soon. And in those days, while Communism is aimed at destroying Religion, and the enemies of God are spreading their insidious doctrines, even in our own beloved Country, we must have a share in building our Church and School to combat these evils. It is not just or right to expect a section of our Parishioners to make sacrifices to build our Church and School. All the members of our Parish should regard it a privilege to have a share in all Parochial projects. Now, therefore, may I ask that you and each wage-earner in our Parish decide to set aside each month, at least, four per cent of your earnings as your contribution towards paying portion of the enormous debt we have accumulated. This contribution should be over and above your regular contribution given every Sunday in your Sunday envelopes. It will mean a sacrifice—a big sacrifice—but it will be a sacrifice you are making for yourselves and your children.

GOD'S CALL

In today's scriptures we hear three instances of people receiving and responding to a call from God. These accounts follow the pattern of most scriptural call narratives: a divine presence appears and speaks; the person expresses fear or unworthiness, receives encouragement, and finally responds to God's call. Today's first reading shows an unworthy Isaiah responding to the Lord's call, "Here I am; send me!" (Isaiah 6:8). In the second reading Paul tells us that, even though he had persecuted the church, he was called to be an apostle. In the Gospel, despite Simon Peter's protest that he is a sinner, Jesus calls James, John, and Simon to follow him. They leave everything they have and follow Jesus—that is, they become Jesus' disciples. These scriptures can challenge us to take stock of our lives. How do we experience Jesus' call to discipleship in our lives? How well and faithfully are we responding?

ST. GENEVIEVE DIAMOND JUBILEE

February 19, 1951

My dear Parishioner:

In this letter, which I am mailing today to all the members of this Parish, I shall try to define, very clearly, our Parochial Program, and the share I hope you will assume in carrying it out. To all who have so generously helped so far I express my sincere thanks. And to those Parishioners who have not been so cooperative may I say that, to share in the Blessings a Parish Church and School will bring, we hope their cooperation will be forthcoming.

THE CHAPEL AND HALL

Daily Mass is celebrated in our Chapel at 7:30 a.m. Confessions are heard in this Chapel on Saturdays and Eves of Holy Days and First Fridays from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. and from 7:30 to 9:00 p.m. Instructions in the Doctrines of the Catholic Church are given in this Chapel on Wednesday evenings at 7:15. To these Instructions I most cordially invite our non-Catholic friends and also our Catholic people who wish to learn more about the Truths of our Holy Faith.

In our Hall, at the rear of the Chapel, Meetings and Social events are held.

MASSES ON SUNDAYS AND HOLY DAYS

Until such time as our Church building is completed, Masses on Sundays and Holy Days are celebrated in the PANORAMA THEATRE, at Van Nuys Boulevard and Nordhoff Street. THE HOURS OF MASSES ARE 7:00, 8:30, 10:00 AND 11:00 A.M.

YOUR NEW PARISH SCHOOL

The Parish School, for the Christian education of children, is being built now. Of reinforced brick construction, it will be an eight grade School, complete with Library, Offices, Doctor's and Nurse's room, etc. It will have a modern inter-communication system in all rooms. There will be a spacious playground area of approximately four acres. The School will face Community Street at the rear of the Church building. In September, five classrooms will open for the education of the children of our Parish. Each year an additional classroom will open, until the eight grades are completed.

THE SISTERS OF SAINT JOSEPH

Last October the Sisters of St. Joseph came to our Parish from Newark, New Jersey, to instruct our children. In one of the small houses, still left standing on our property, the Sisters now live. They have been taking a census of our Catholic people in this Parish, and in every home they have visited so far they have received an assurance of the cooperation of our Parishioners.

The Sisters also conduct Religious Instruction Classes for the children on Mondays and Thursdays—two Classes each day—from 2:30 to 3:30 and from 3:45 to 4:45 p.m.
