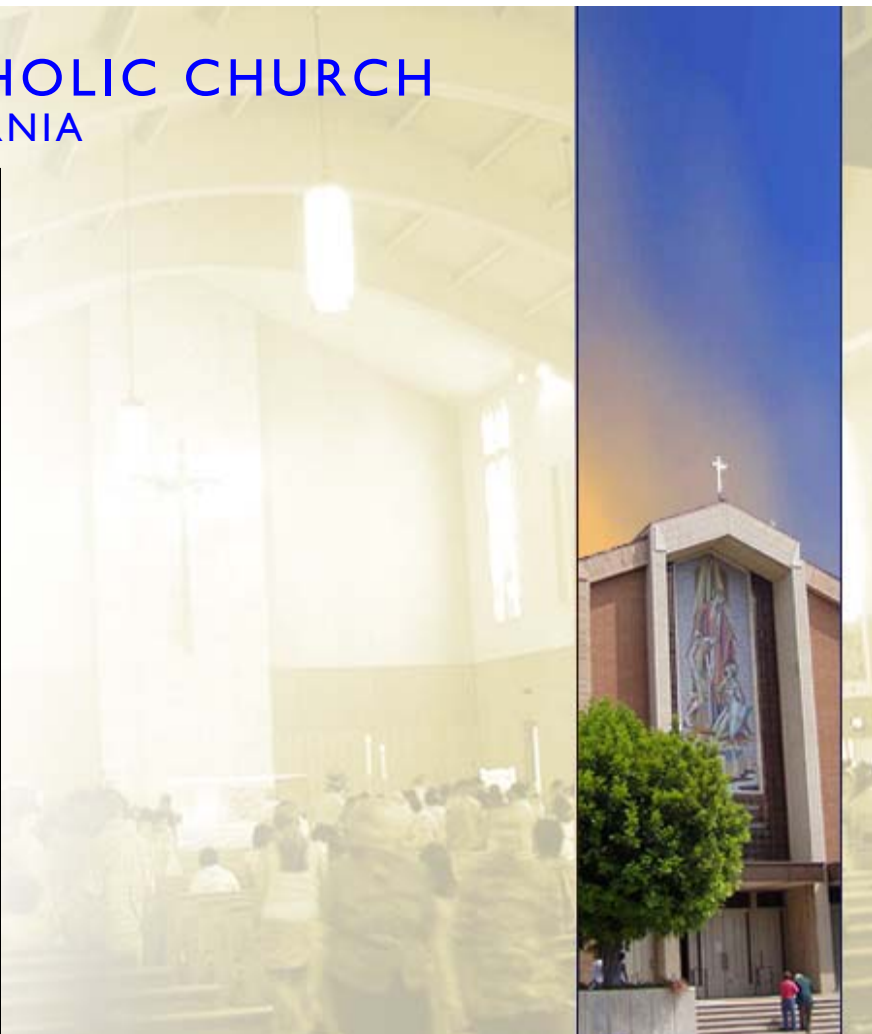

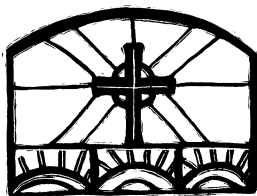

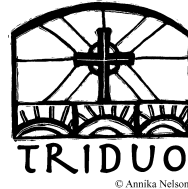

LA VISITA A LAS SIETE IGLESIAS

La noche del Jueves Santo, después de trasladar al Santísimo Sacramento al monumento para la adoración de los fieles, existe la tradición popular de visitar siete iglesias o templos. Dicha tradición se inició gracias al fervor eucarístico de San Felipe Neri (1515-1595), motivando a la gente que al visitar los templos para la adoración al Santísimo Sacramento también meditara los siete momentos o "visitas" que Jesús realizó la noche de su juicio. La meditación comienza precisamente en el huerto de los olivos para concluir en el Calvario. El hecho de que Jesús sea llevado de un lado a otro, se recuerda en un contexto de fe y adoración. Para las visitas no hay ritual establecido, la práctica popular es rezar una estación al Santísimo Sacramento (Tres Padrenuestros, incluyendo Avemaría, Gloria al Padre y la jaculatoria eucarística) y luego dejar un momento de silencio para acompañar a Jesús en su agonía. La última visita debe ser en la parroquia doméstica.

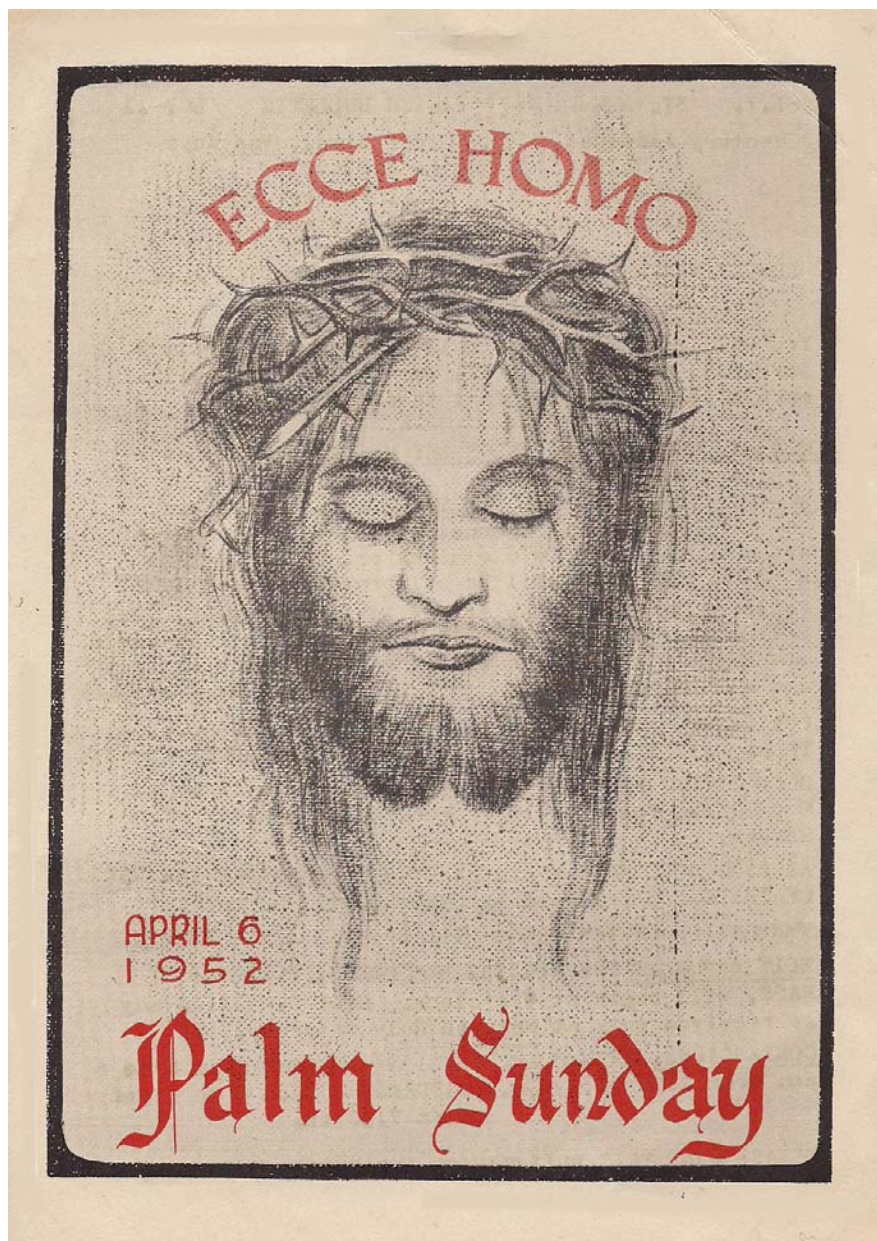
