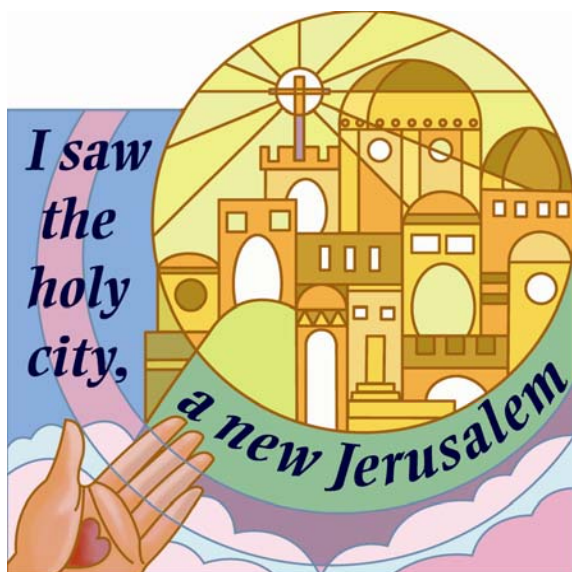

## MAY 2, 2010—5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

### BEYOND THE RULES

Certain religious groups have taken the banning of prayer in public schools as a threat to the expression of religion in public life. They have successfully lobbied many state and local governments to display the Ten Commandments in public buildings. Some claim that the commandments represent the moral and legal foundation of American society, showing “what this country stands for.” Yet no one is advocating the public display of Jesus’ words about loving God and neighbor (Matthew 22:36–40). Which is easier to do? Keep the rules, or love someone you dislike or even hate? Jesus says love your enemies, especially the personal ones: the colleague who got the big promotion, the daughter who promised not to drink but is arrested for DUI, the husband who has affairs, the company that scammed you out of hard-earned dollars.

When we hear the One on the throne say “I make all things new” (Revelation 21:5), we are invited into a new world order in which we center our lives not only on rules, but on loving the unlovable. We can only call ourselves Christ’s disciples if we love people as he loved—warts and all—and then let go of the grudges and hatreds.

As Paul noted in his second letter to the church at Corinth, if we are in Christ, then we are a new creation. And disciples who are a new creation, who live in the new heaven and earth brought about by Christ, are also daily practitioners of a new commandment: to love one another with that transforming, re-newing love that Christ bestowed on us.

#### **Who are the perpetrators?**

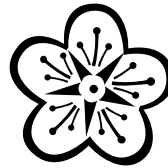
According to data provided by the L.A. City Attorney’s Office, parents constitute 84 percent of the child abuse perpetrators, while caregivers, relatives, foster parents, and babysitters constitute the rest. Sixty percent of perpetrators are female, whose median age is 31 years. Como observara san Pablo en la segunda carta a la iglesia de Corinto, si estamos en Cristo, entonces somos una nueva creación. Y aquellos discípulos que son también una nueva creación, que viven en el nuevo cielo y la nueva tierra que trae Cristo, también son los diarios practicantes del nuevo mandamiento de amarse unos a otros con el amor transformador y renovador que Cristo nos ha otorgado.

### SANTOS FELIPE Y SANTIAGO (Siglo I)

#### 3 de mayo

Felipe nació en Bastida y fue discípulo de Juan Bautista. Él mismo descubrió en la persona de Jesús al Mesías, al anunciado en el Antiguo Testamento y va a comunicarlo a los demás. Asimismo, el evangelista pone en boca de Felipe la falta de fe: 'Ni doscientos denarios (salario por un día de trabajo) bastarían para darle de comer a esta multitud'. Jesús multiplica el pan y alimenta a la multitud. Se cree que Felipe murió hacia el año 87 y sus restos fueron llevados a Roma, a la Iglesia de los Apóstoles, junto a los de Santiago, de ahí que la fiesta litúrgica sea el mismo día. Santiago “el menor” es el hijo de Alfeo y también pertenece a los Doce. Fue obispo de Jerusalén a partir del año 42, debido a la muerte de Santiago “el mayor”. Fue él mismo quien escribió la carta canónica que aparece en el Nuevo Testamento. El historiador Flavio Josefo nos dice que fue martirizado en el año 62 debido a una orden de lapidación emitida por el sumo sacerdote Anás II.

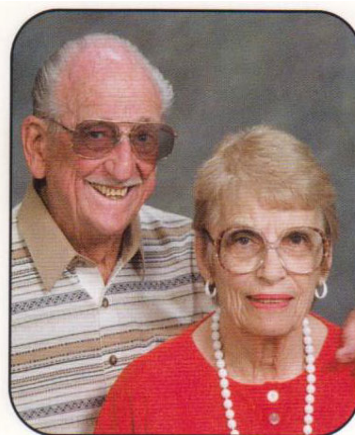
