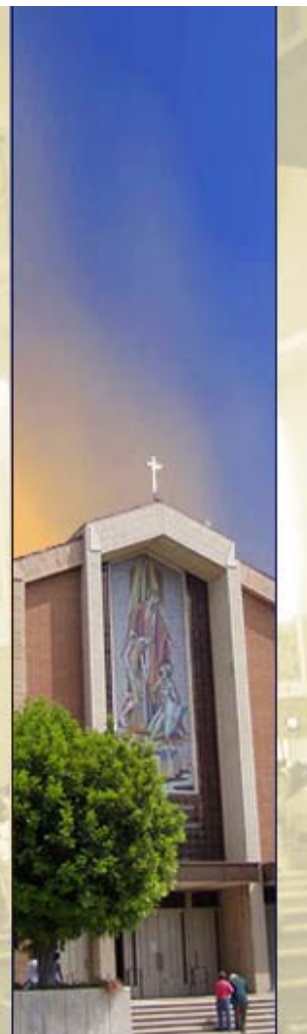

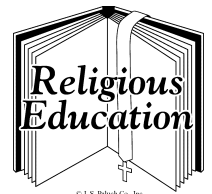

Our oldest son and his family are also very active in their church.
